2. China's smart home market continued to grow from 2016 to 2020, increasing 11.4% year-on-year up to a market value of RMB 170.5 billion in 2020. By 2022, the market is expected to exceed RMB 200 billion.

3. The smart home system market grew rapidly despite an overall decline in the finished-house market, with approximately 658 thousand built in the third quarter of 2021. Around 65 thousand smart home systems were used in finished-houses in the same period, constituting a year-on-year increase of 24.5%.

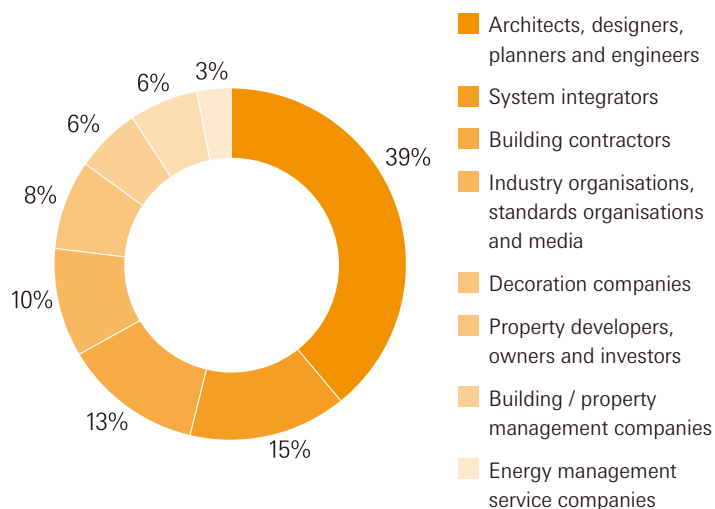

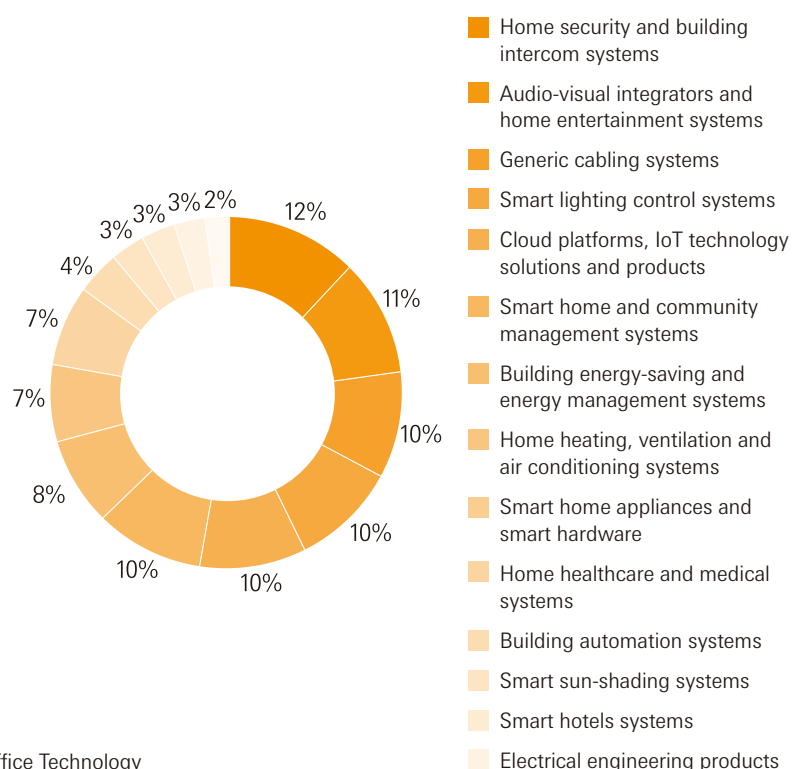
